

Boating on the Lower Deschutes

Boating, floating and other water recreation on the Lower Deschutes is regulated. Visit www.boaterpass.com to:

- Buy a Pass
- Confirm a Reservation
- Replace a Lost Pass
- Cancel a Reservation

Depending on the river segment and the nature of your trip, you will need one of these passes:

- Daily (For all segments of the river)
- Frequent User (available only at Prineville, Oregon BLM office)
- Limited Entry (see below)

Limited Entry Pass

Certain river segments are subject to controlled entry in the summer. These river segments can change from year to year. Check www.boaterpass.com for the most up-to-date information.

Think Ahead, and Know

- Trip start and end date
- Number of people on trip
- Launch and take out points
- Trip leader's name, address, driver's license number & date of birth
