Reserve early! Reserve campsites and group areas two days to nine months in advance by phone: Reservations Northwest (1-800-452-5687). Campsites also are reservable through www.oregonstateparks.org.

Joseph H. Stewart State Recreation Area overlooks the Rogue River's scenic Lost Creek Reservoir, a popular camping destination for hikers and bikers as well as for anglers and boaters.

Discovery Season

From October 1-April 30, you can rent a full, electric, or tent site for less. At most state parks, including Joseph H. Stewart, you can save \$4 off summer rates.

Plan a Picnic

The park has two day-use picnic areas. Picnic area C can accommodate as many as 200 people and is reservable. Picnic area A is next to a large swimming area. There is no lifeguard on duty, so remember to play it safe. The day-use area also has an activity field and horseshoe pits.

Boating and Fishing

A boat ramp near the day-use area and a moorage facility serve visiting boaters. The marina near the day-use parking lot offers boat rentals and a store with a cafe.

Anglers troll the 10-mile-long reservoir all year for trout and bass. A fish cleaning station is located next to the boat launch parking lot.

Take a Hike, or Ride a Bike

Stretch your legs on the 5 1/2 miles of hiking trails and another 6 miles of bike paths, all within the park. The trails connect the day-use area with the campground and extend beyond the park boundaries to connect with other trails. The park is near the U.S. Forest Service's Upper Rogue River hiking trail, which connects with the Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail near Crater Lake.

What's Nearby

Crater Lake National Park is 36 miles northeast of Joseph Stewart on Highway 62. Don't miss one of Oregon's most scenic attractions. The pristine setting and clear, blue Crater Lake attract a half-million visitors each year. The lake was formed more than 6,000 years ago by the eruption and collapse of Mt. Mazama. A wide variety of accommodations and visitor services are available, many of them year round.

Casey State Recreation Site, 5 miles to the west, and **Tou Velle State Recreation Site**, 25 miles southwest, are outstanding access points for fishing on the Rogue River. Both parks have boat ramps and are nice places to picnic.

Cole Rivers Fish Hatchery, the largest hatchery in Oregon, is open for self-guided tours.

Prospect State Scenic Viewpoint, 10 miles northeast on Mill Creek Drive, features a forested trail to Pearsony Falls.

Jacksonville, just west of Medford, is a national historic landmark with commercial buildings, residences, churches and museums dating from the 1880's.

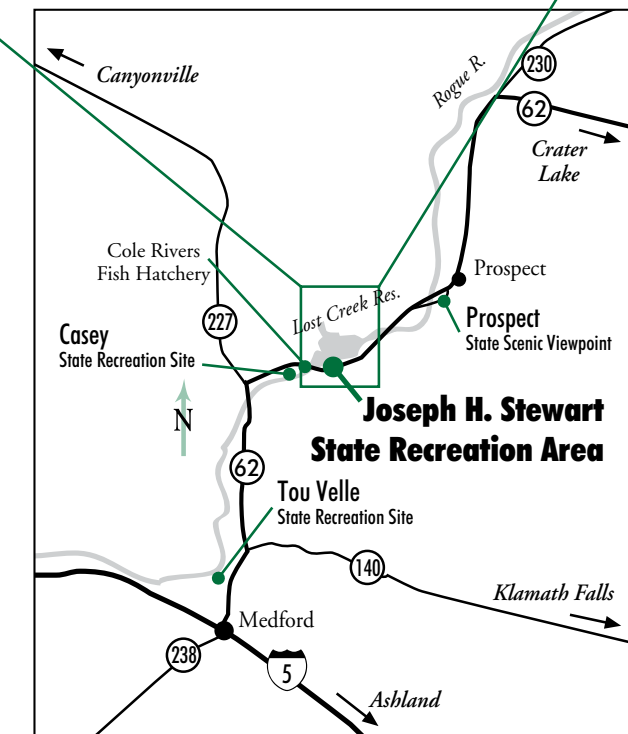
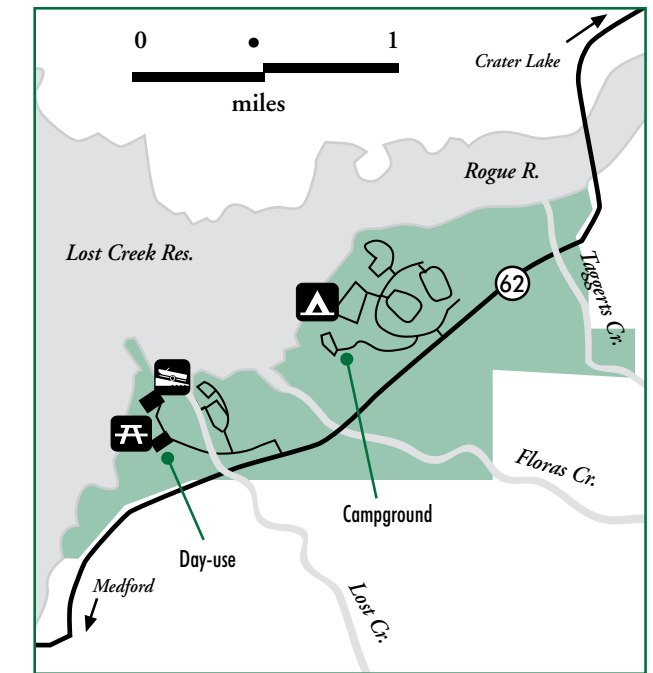
Ashland, 15 miles south of Medford, is home of the Oregon Shakespearean Festival. The season runs from mid-February to October.

Please help make camping here a safe and enjoyable experience by following these and other park rules:

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Vehicles must be parked on paved areas only.
- Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but ride them with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
- Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All waste must be properly removed. (See our "Pets in Parks" brochure for details.)
